The lowest passing grade is «E» and «passed». Students are only permitted to enroll in the next year of study and to be awarded a diploma if they have passing grades in each subject of the curriculum.

Grading Criteria:

- «A» is awarded to a student for thorough and deep knowledge of the subject, and ability to correctly work with tasks on the subject independently;
- «B» deserves a student for full knowledge of the subject and successful fulfilling of the tasks on the subject;
- «E» deserves a student for sufficient knowledge of the subject;
- «F» deserves a student for substantial gaps in his knowledge of the subject and principal mistakes in fulfilling tasks.
